Process to become a YSC member

To become a member of the Youth Sports Coalition organizations must meet and maintain the following member qualifications:

- A non-profit or not-for-profit youth organization.
- Must have a minimum of 200 Roseville resident participants.
- Must not have more than a 30% non-resident participation.
- Conduct open registration regardless of skill level.
- Maintain a national and/or state affiliation.
- Follow National Alliance of Youth Sports (NAYS) or equivalent program as defined by the Department.
- Operate through volunteer coaches and board of directors.
- Provide an "everyone plays" philosophy.

Qualifying organizations will need to complete a membership application that will be reviewed by the Department. The Department will verify the qualifications. If the organization meets the qualifications they will be invited to join the coalition.

Once qualified as a Youth Sports Coalition member, any organization not meeting or maintaining any of these qualification in one calendar year of allocations will be placed on probation and will be expected to become compliant with these qualifications within 2 calendar years of allocations or be dropped as a Youth Sports Coalition member.
