What is the Swimming Pool Cover Rebate Program?

The program will assist home owners, apartment owners and businesses with costs related to the installation of a swimming pool cover. The Program is subject to budget funding each fiscal year. Rebates are first-come, first-serve and will continue until program funding has been depleted.

Why is the program available?

Pool covers help reduce the cost of pool ownership and maintenance by:

Reducing evaporation

Pool covers keep water lost to evaporation to a minimum. An average pool can lose up to 10,000 to 15,000 gallons of water per year due to evaporation.

Minimizing heat loss

Evaporation is the major source of heat loss for all swimming pools. 90% of heat loss is from the surface of the pool. The best way to minimize evaporation is by covering your pool when not in use.

Improving water cleanliness

Approximately 80-90% of debris (leaves, dirt, insects, etc) can be kept out of the pool with the aid of a well-fitted pool cover. This also increases the quality of your pool water and significantly reduces the workload on your pool cleaning system.

Other benefits

A pool cover can help reduce the total cost of pool chemical consumption by 35-60%. A properly fitting pool cover can increase pool water temperature by up to 6-8 degrees extending the swimming season without using other forms of heating.

Who is eligible to participate in this program?

All City of Roseville water customers who own properties that have exterior swimming pools at their place of residence or business that don't currently have a pool cover. The rebate is limited to one pool cover per customer, per service address.

How do I receive a rebate?

Call the City of Roseville Water Conservation Division at 774-5761 to confirm rebates are still available.

Purchase and install a well fitting pool cover

Complete the rebate application form and attach a copy of a valid sales receipt for the purchase of the pool cover.

City staff will contact you upon receipt of your application and may schedule a follow up appointment to verify installation.

Once verification is complete, procedures will be started to issue a rebate check. Checks will be mailed within 45 days after information is verified.

Rebate Amount

A \$50 rebate, or 50% of the purchase price of a new pool cover, whichever is less, or

A \$200 rebate for the purchase of a permanent, mechanical pool cover
