A. ORDINANCE AMENDMENT FOR THE DOWNTOWN SPECIFIC PLAN DOWNTOWN CODE - CITYWIDE - FILE 2012PL-021; PROJECT #OA-000027.

The Planning Department proposes a change to the City's Downtown Specific Plan Downtown Code as it relates to Open Air Vendors. To better accommodate the "bricks and mortar" businesses located within the Downtown Specific Plan, the revision will modify the existing requirement of a 100 foot separation from a permanent business that sells the same "item" to "food or beverage items".
