Contest Information

To celebrate what makes Roseville great, we are holding a photography contest. Anyone who takes photos in the Roseville city limits is eligible to compete in the "Take A Shot" photo contest. The photos do not have to be taken during a specified time frame, but should appear current. Photographers who have earned an income from the sale of past print or digital images are only eligible to compete in the Professional category.


The eight categories are listed below with examples of each. Photographers must identify in which category they would like to compete. Only one category per photo is accepted. You may submit multiple photos in various categories; however, photographers may only win in one category.

- Downtown Roseville
 Town Square, Historic Old Town
- The Great Outdoors
 Parks, Landscape, Nature, Bikeways, Trails
- People
 Kids, Family, Friends
- Business & Culture
 Arts, Museums, Libraries, Buildings, Commerce
- Celebrations
 Downtown Holiday Celebration, Events, Parades
- Sports
 Little League, Softball, Swimming, Fun Runs, Biking
- Local Heroes
 Police, Volunteers, Firefighters, Lifeguards, Teachers
- Professional
 Any subject by photographers who have earned income from the sale of print or digital images.

All photographs must be in a digital format.

Photo Displays

All photographs submitted may be enlarged and framed for display in city facilities.

Awards

Category Winners - \$50

Judges choose a winner from each category.

Best of the Best - \$100

Judges select overall best photo from the category winners.

Fan Favorite - \$150

After submitting all photos in appropriate categories, submitters choose one photograph to compete for Fan Favorite. The file name of your Fan Favorite nominee must be listed on the entry form. (The City reserves the right to include additional photos in the Fan Favorite category.) Fan Favorite photos and photographers' names will be posted on the Roseville Park, Recreation & Events Facebook page. The photo with the most "likes" wins. Voting is open Friday, February 7 thru Friday, February 28.

Submitting Photographs

All photos entered must be in a digital format. Entries must be accompanied by a completed contest entry form (electronic form available at www.roseville.ca.us/photocontest). There are no limits on entries; submit as many digital photographs as you wish. If you are submitting in multiple categories, you must indicate the category name in the file or folder name. Only one category per photo. Entries are due January 31, 2014.

The minimum resolution is 300 dpi (dots per inch). The best option is to keep the photograph at its original resolution - high resolution is preferred. Minor digital enhancements are permitted, but images that have been significantly modified or appear unnatural will be disqualified.
