Temporary Bridge Decking

New temporary bridge decking on Douglas Boulevard.

The temporary bridge decks will allow all lanes of traffic to remain open on Douglas while the contractor spends the next few months digging out the earth from underneath to construct the concrete tunnel box. Toward the end of this year, those deck panels will be used on Sunrise Avenue.

Tunnel Entrance



This picture shows the entrance to the tunnel. The photographer is standing north of Oakridge Drive and the camera is facing north. The notches in the walls will be where the tunnel portal (entrance) will be located.

Loop off-ramp

This is a view looking north with the photographer standing north of Douglas. The short segment of tunnel you see under construction

will end up being located under the eastbound I-80 to west-bound Douglas loop offramp. The



contractor moved the existing loop offramp to the north to make room to construct this short segment of tunnel. The contractor will then move the loop back to its original position over the top of the new tunnel segment.
