☐ EXISTING LAND USE Are there specific problems or incompatibility issues? Underutilized properties?	
□ NEW DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL Areas that have significant potential? What types of development are appropriate? Challenges facing new development?	
☐ USE OF SPACES Are there certain spaces in the project area people use more often than others? Are there qualities that make a space friendlier to "hanging out" than others?	
☐ PUBLIC SPACES Opportunities for public spaces?  Types of public spaces desired (active or passive recreational, plazas, gathering places, parks, etc.)?	
☐ ARCHITECTURE How does the architecture contribute to your experience of Downtown? What elements do you like best? Are there areas for improvement?	
☐ STREETSCAPE ELEMENTS Are the existing street trees, curbs, sidewalks, working? What element could improve the environment? What areas would benefit from improved streetscape?	
☐ PUBLIC AMENITIES Are there amenities that work well (benches, bus stops, etc.)? Are there other public features you'd like to see (shaded sitting areas, water features, etc.)?	
☐ PUBLIC ART Appropriate locations for public art? What types of art? Are there locations that work well?	
☐ PEDESTRIAN UTILIZATION Are there problem areas?  Are there locations that work well? What features would increase pedestrian use? Are areas accessible to persons with disabilities?	
☐ WALKING SURFACES Are there specific problems? Materials liked? Maintenance issues?	
☐ BIKE UTILIZATION How can bicycle use be increased? Locations where bicycles would work well? What features would increase bike utilization?	
☐ CIRCULATION AND SAFETY Are the safety concerns? What elements contribute to safety concerns? How are the side streets working? Are pedestrians safe?	
☐ PARKING AND LOADING How is parking working? Are there problem areas? Are there locations that work well? Are loading areas working okay? How can parking be improved?
