

OBJECTIVES

At the November 16th Steering committee meeting, the committee did an exercise where a list of 38 possible objectives was evaluated in relation to the 7 goals established for the Roseville Hazard Mitigation Plan. Each objective was reviewed to determine how many of the goals that objective would meet. The results of this exercise are illustrated in table 1. It was determined that 17 of the 38 objectives addressed 3 or more of the goals. These objectives are illustrated in table 2. A review of these 17 objectives by the planning team determined that combining and blending some of the objectives could further refine these objectives. Table 3 illustrates these blended objectives and also indicates which original objectives they were created from. Please refer to the Objectives catalog for a list of all 38 objectives. As a reminder, the goals for this plan are as follows:

1. **Protect lives and reduce injury.**
2. **Promote hazard mitigation as an integrated policy.**
3. **Protect the continuity of local government to ensure no significant disruption of services during or due to a disaster.**
4. **Improve community emergency management preparedness, collaboration, and outreach.**
5. **Minimize or reduce damage to property including critical facilities.**
6. **Develop and implement mitigation strategies that optimize public funds in an efficient and cost-effective way.**
7. **Maintain, enhance, and restore the natural environment’s capacity to deal with the impacts of disasters.**
