Contest Rules:

- Must be a 9th-12th grade student within Placer County to enter (homeschool students welcome).
- Must be an original poem or prose (any theme/form acceptable).
- Must be a minimum of 5 lines and a maximum of 40 lines.
- Must be unpublished and not plagiarized.
- No explicit writing.
- Must be submitted in a Word Document via email with the subject line: "Teen Placer Poets Competition" by 11:59pm Saturday, March 30th to library@roseville.ca.us.
- Include your full name, phone number, email and high school, along with a 2-4 sentence biography on a separate page of the same document.
