


EU's Great Crew!

On February 5, Kobra Properties celebrated the installation of the last steel beam on their 58,000 sq ft., Class-A office building at Vernon and Grant Street. At their "topping off" celebration, several representatives from Kobra, Stonegate Construction, the City of Roseville and the Redevelopment Agency marked this important milestone by signing the final beam prior to its placement at the top of the building.
