RE: Invitation to Participate

Dear

You and one additional representative are invited to attend a meeting on November 30, 2009 at the Downtown Library from 6:00 to 7:00 pm. The purpose of the meeting is to introduce to you the concept of a Veterans Coalition and gather feedback.

Background

The City of Roseville has been working on an update to the current Memorial/Monument Policy. We recognize and value to participation of our veterans in honoring veterans of all wars. In order to ensure a consistent and cohesive approach, in this revision, the policy includes the formation of a Veterans Coalition made up of representatives from the local Veterans groups. The draft policy states,

“Requests regarding memorials or monuments related to veterans, wars or military organizations shall be presented to the City through a coalition of veterans groups. This veterans’ coalition shall consist of one representative from each active veterans group in Roseville and include a minimum of three at-large members. Participation with the veterans’ coalition shall be voluntary and the opportunity for any veterans group to participate shall be open. The veterans’ coalition shall be self-administered. If an active veterans group chooses not to participate in the coalition, the coalition may still exist and perform the functions as outlined below. The minimum number of participants in the coalition shall be at least one member of each known Roseville veterans group.

Requests related to such memorials or monuments, either for new pieces or for modification to existing pieces, shall first be presented to the veterans’ coalition. All requests must be supported by a majority vote of the veterans’ coalition prior to being forwarded to the City for consideration. The City will only consider requests that have support from and have been forwarded by the veterans’ coalition.”

To emphasize two key points; 1) participation is voluntary; and 2) a minimum of three at-large members will be invited to participate in the Coalition.
