K-9 UNIT DEMONSTRATION REQUESTS AND GUIDELINES



Thank you for your interest in having the Roseville Police Department's K-9 Unit perform for your community event, school, or organization. The K-9 Unit provides free demonstrations to a variety of community groups in Roseville throughout the year. We facilitate two kinds of demonstrations.

MEET AND GREET: The officer brings his K-9 partner to your event and describes the function and background of the K-9 Unit.

DEMONSTRATION:

The K-9 team provides a demonstration of K-9 deployments, which typically includes apprehension of suspects in "bite" suits. *Please be aware that for safety reasons, we do not allow petting of our K-9 partners*. Once you have been scheduled, an officer will meet with you to help facilitate your demonstration and approve the location.

Please fill out the following questionnaire so that we can accommodate your request. We do ask that you attempt to give at least 45 days advance notice due to the officers' patrol shifts, and to prevent a conflict with other scheduled demonstrations.
