

City of Roseville, Teens Roseville Live (TRL) Dance Policy

The following policies are designed to promote an environment in which all students and staff are and feel safe and comfortable. Enforcement of the dress and dance codes is at the discretion of the City of Roseville staff.

Dance Policy:

Students attending TRL are expected to treat all staff, peers and themselves with respect. Failure to do so or violation of any part of the dance policy will result in immediate removal from the dance, their parents will be called, and they may be prohibited from attending future dances.

- All students must present a current and valid school ID to a City of Roseville middle school to enter the
 dance. If a student does not have an ID, they will <u>NOT</u> be admitted into the dance.
- City of Roseville Middle Schools include Antelope Creek, Buljan, Cavitt, Chilton, Cooley, Creekview Ranch, Eich, Olympus, Silverado, St. Albans, and St. Rose (Roseville Charter Schools and Roseville homeschooled students will be accepted).
- All students must be in the 7th or 8th grade (no exceptions).
- Admittance into the dance will cost \$10 for each student.
- Once a student is admitted into the dance, he or she will not be allowed to leave before 9:55pm unless they are signed out by their parent/guardian.
- All purses, backpacks and bags will be thoroughly examined prior to entry. Once the student is admitted
 into the dance they are required to check their personal belongings into the coat check area.
- Anyone suspected of substance abuse will not be admitted. If participant has used a substance, he/she will be subject to disciplinary action and will be unable to attend future dances.
- Students must be picked up no later than 15 minutes after the dance ends. Failure to do so might result
 in not being able to attend future dances. If student has not been picked up within 30 minutes after the
 dance ends Roseville PD will be notified.
- No inappropriate or suggestive dancing will be allowed. Twerking, freak dancing, grinding, rubbing another person, or any sexually simulated act will not be tolerated.
- No body parts other than feet may be touching the dance floor.
- No dancing which could cause harm to one's self or others will be tolerated ("slam dancing" or "moshing").
- At the discretion of City of Roseville staff, if dancing/behavior become inappropriate, the music will be turned off and the dance may be cancelled. NO REFUNDS WILL BE PROVIDED.
- Students shall dress in accordance to the City of Roseville, Teens Roseville Live dress code policy.



City of Roseville, Teens Roseville Live (TRL) Dress Code Policy

The TRL dress code policy reflects the City's belief that students will dress with respect for themselves, as well as others, and recognize the object of TRL is for students to have fun and socialize. Parents are asked to monitor students in their care and counsel them on appropriate choices.

Dress Code Requirements:

- Students are expected to wear clean, neat, and well-maintained clothing.
- Shoes must be worn at all times
- Printing and/or graphics depicting drugs, alcohol, tobacco, sexually suggestive material, or that are disrespectful, are prohibited.
- Clothing or accessories that are indicators of gang involvement are prohibited. No bandanas may be worn or displayed at any time.
- Strapless tops, halter tops, backless tops, tube tops, and bare midriffs are prohibited. Tops revealing cleavage are prohibited. A strap on each shoulder is required.
- Undergarments are not to be visible. No "see-through" "lace" or "fishnet" clothing.
- Shorts, skirts and dresses must be appropriate length.
- Undershirt style tank tops and tank tops with low cut arm holes or "muscle shirts" are not permitted.
- Clothing that covers face is not permitted (masks, Morph suits, hoodies with masks, etc.).
- No wallet chains, spiked or bicycle wristbands, or other possibly dangerous clothing or accessories.
- Clothing may not be removed or altered once the student has entered the dance.
- Oversized pants are not allowed, and pants must stay up without a belt. Sagging pants may not be worn.

The City of Roseville staff reserves the right to decide the appropriateness of the student's attire. Inappropriately dressed students will be asked to change clothing or parents will be contacted to bring appropriate clothing or remove their child from the dance.
