Certification for Generators of Photographic Silver Waste

Senate Bill 2111, which became effective January 1, 1999, and changes to the Health and Safety Code Section 25143.12 provides some regulatory relief for generators that produce waste that is hazardous solely due to the presence of silver. Businesses that meet the conditions outlined below may use this certification in lieu of being inspected by Roseville's Hazardous Material Officer and being billed by the city as a Hazardous Waste Generator.

I certify under penalty of law that:

- _____ is not a generator of any hazardous waste except
name of company/organization photographic silver-only hazardous waste.
- The amount of photographic silver-only hazardous waste generated is less than 100 kilograms (27 gallons) per month.
- Photographic waste containing more than 5 mg/l silver is not discharged to the sewer.
- The transportation of the silver-only hazardous waste is performed according to federal hazardous waste management and transportation requirements.
- The silver from the silver-only hazardous waste is recovered on-site or at an off-site facility.
